Deadline to purchase your ticket is Dec. 15, 2013

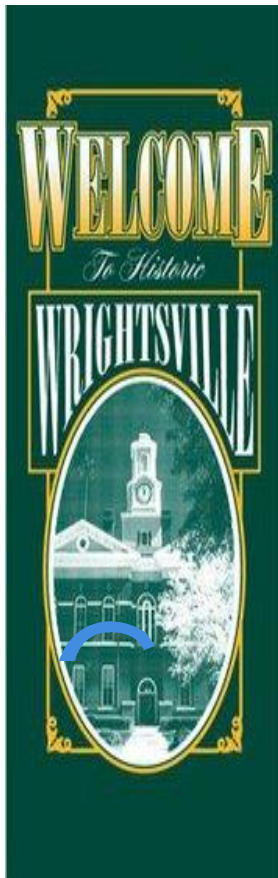
SANTA CLAUSE
